However, they cannot remain in post again this year and, at present, we have had no nominees come forward to take over the chair role. This means we again face the possibility of closing, effective from 23rd April. I'm sure all of you will agree that we cannot let this happen. The Early Years sector is already struggling to offer enough places to those who need them, and despite these tough economic times, we have been able to not only keep our doors open, but we are still able to provide high quality care at a relatively low hourly fee rate.

#### Lunch club
